



Are you properly equipped to save lives? Use the checklist

When someone near you is seriously injured, it is important to be able to act quickly. Use the checklist to make sure you are properly equipped to deal with the risks at your workplace.

**Adapt the First Aid equipment to your specific needs.
It could save a life.**

- ☐ The choice of First Aid equipment is based on a documented risk assessment.
- ☐ There is First Aid equipment available for providing effective First Aid to both employees and visitors.
- ☐ The First Aid equipment is positioned so that it is close to everyone and is easy to find.
- ☐ The equipment is marked with signs to guide you.
- ☐ There are always enough people who can give First Aid.
- ☐ Everyone knows what to do in the event of an accident.
- ☐ There are signs indicating where First Aid equipment is located, who can provide First Aid, phone numbers for ambulances and taxis, and the address of the workplace.
- ☐ Everyone who works outside the stationary workplace has suitably adapted First Aid equipment available to take with them.
- ☐ There are procedures in place for regularly checking the equipment.
- ☐ The checks are documented.
- ☐ There are procedures for crisis support.
- ☐ There is a permanently installed eye shower as well as eyewash bottles available where corrosive chemicals are handled.
- ☐ Burn injury products are available in case of risk of burns.
- ☐ There is a responsible person appointed for each First Aid unit.
- ☐ No product has passed its expiration date.
